

2025 STEAM WEEK AT ASCOT STATE SCHOOL

In Week 4 (27th–31st October), we will be celebrating Ascot's annual **STEAM Week** — a celebration of **Science**, **Technology**, **Engineering**, **the Arts and Mathematics**.

Throughout the week, students will have the opportunity to take part in a **whole-school incursion by Street Science**, as well as participate in a range of engaging **lunchtime**, **class-based activities and competitions**. Participation in these additional activities is optional.

Activity Costs:

Incursion costs were included earlier in the year, via the Student Resource Scheme (SRS).

Street Science	Prep	Snow Making: Students will engage in a dynamic and highly interactive 30-minute
Incursion		stage show. The show is followed by hands-on investigation sessions, where each
		student makes and explores the unique properties of instant snow.
	Year 1	Cheeky Changes: Students will be guided through a procedure and discussions to
		make, describe and compare physical changes of PVA bouncy balls.
	Year 2	Perfect Polymers: Students investigate the properties of different materials,
		combining safe chemicals to make and describe their very own slime and instant snow.
	Year 3	Hardcore Heat: Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of chemical reactions
		by using thermometers to measure how heat can be produced and absorbed.
	Year 4	Rocket Science: Students will investigate Newton's laws of physics within the
		stimulating context of building and launching CO2 rockets.
	Year 5	Perfect Polymers – Non-Newtonian Fluids: Students will discuss the motion and
		arrangement of particles within solids, liquids and gases and how this impacts
		observable properties. Students will investigate mysterious polymers.
	Year 6	Perfect Polymers - Chemistry in Action: Students apply their understanding of fair
		testing to create two different polymers by changing one variable. They then explore
		another polymer that demonstrates a reversible physical change.

- 2. Maths photo competition
